- Main problems litter and disposal of solid waste; Hundreds of tons of waste over 50 yrs was never taken down the hill as it was too cumbersome and costly.

#### WHY THE PROJECT WORKED?

All stake holders came to understand the subject and work together.

A multipartite committee was formed

Municipal authority, the NGO - Matheran Bachao Samiti (MBS), ICPE, Hoteliers, shopkeepers and Bisleri



#### WHY THE PROJECT WORKED?



- Regular meetings were held.
- Council Provided separate plot for dry wastes collection
- ICPE involved recyclers to take waste away from the hill for recycling.
- The loop was completed

- The commercial establishments helped in putting up sign boards for anti litter messages.
- The Council provided separate bins for wet and dry waste collection.
- Jumbo bags were provided by ICPE for plastics waste collection.

## Awareness, Education & Communication - Why & How?



Awareness activities were conducted by ICPE in the schools to educate the locals people.

> Bisleri installed Compactor Machines to

crush PET bottles.



## Improvements seen



- Now almost 20,000 to 25,000 empty bottles are carried away monthly in tourist season time which go to PET recyclers.
- 30 to 40 bags of used polybags, packets, wrappers are taken away twice a week by self employed villagers from valley below who have linked up with recycling units near Karjat, Mahad, Ulhasnagar etc.
- Steady income stream is now in place for 8 to 10 families who have learnt a new vocation.





Matheran is now clean and free of garbage

- Matheran declared one of the cleanest hill stations of India in November 2002.
- Won unique appreciation by the Expert Committee on New & Proposed Eco-Sensitive Zones constituted by Ministry of Environment & Forest (MoEF).
- The state awarded Matheran the Cleanest Municipality at district level and 2nd cleanest in Konkan Division.
- Matheran a model hill station with a complete waste management system.
